Unfortunately, fire statistics data show that most of the fires in outdoor accommodation facilities for tourists are caused by equipment and camping gear belonging to guests.

For your own and other guests' safety you will therefore obey the rules set out below as a precaution.

Containers and gas camping equipment are a major risk factor both in starting fire and as highly explosive material. Keep in mind:

- **Do not use gas cylinders over 5 kg. Do not keep any spare gas cylinders**, because they increase risks.
- **Always place the gas cylinder in the shade and keep it clearly visible**. You might need to remove it, so never use chains, padlocks or locks.
- **Double-check that the gas cylinder is properly connected to gas supply and that its hose meets safety standards**.
- **Electrical equipment must never be on while you are out**. Ovens, cookers, stoves, electric fans, and heaters are the most dangerous items, but fridges and air conditioners may also be dangerous if you leave them unattended for several hours.
- **Never leave more than one electrical device charging in a single socket. Never use multiple sockets/plugs.**
- **Never leave a fire unattended while you are out** (any kind of flame, lantern, camping stove, etc.).
- **Do not use flammable cloth and fabrics.**
